

CITY OF WILDOMAR MEASURE AA OVERSIGHT ADVISORY COMMITTEE NOTICE OF VACANCIES

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Wildomar is seeking applications for **3 scheduled vacancies** on the Measure AA Oversight Advisory Committee. The Committee is comprised of five members and serves as established by the City Council. The Committee's role is to ensure that all revenues received from the voter approved onecent transactions and use tax (Measure AA) are spent on permissible uses as outlined in City of Wildomar Ordinance 161 and City Municipal Code Chapter 3.22.

The 3 scheduled vacancies will be for a term expiring June 2024. Committee meetings are scheduled for 7:00 p.m. on the fourth Thursday of February, May, August and the first Thursday in December, immediately following the Measure Z Oversight Advisory Committee. Each Committee Member serves with no compensation. The appointments are made at-large and are voted upon by the entire City Council. The tentative date for Council to select the appointment is at the July 13, 2022 City Council Meeting.

Qualifications for Committee Members are:

- 1. Must be at least 18 years old.
- 2. Must reside within the City limit of Wildomar.
- 3. May not be a City Employee, City Official or Vendor/Contractor/Consultant doing business with the City.
