### **DISCUSSION:**

In accordance with the reporting requirements of Measure Z, Staff is pleased to present the second Quarter FY 2016-17 report (July 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016) of financial activities.

The annual revenues from the tax assessment are budgeted at \$331,900 which will be received in January and May.

The expenditures for the first six months of the fiscal year were \$ 119,923 as compared to \$145,038 in FY 2015-16 at the mid-year. The fund balance budget remains at \$49,376 or 14.7% of the budgeted operating expenditures.
