

Mandatory Recycling For Businesses & Multi-Family Complexes



Did You Know? California's Mandatory Commercial Recycling Law (AB 341), requires businesses and multi-family properties to recycle.

COMMERCIAL RECYCLING (AB 341)

Businesses that generate at least four cubic yards of solid waste per week and multi-family properties with five units or more, must have a recycling program in place.



Did You Know? California's Mandatory Organic Waste Recycling Law (AB 1826), requires businesses and multi-family properties to arrange for organic waste recycling services.

ORGANICS RECYCLING (AB 1826)

Businesses and multi-family properties of five units or more, that generate two cubic yards of solid waste per week, must have organic waste recycling services.



Current Regulations

Since January 1, 2019, businesses that generate 4 cubic yards or more of solid waste per week must have organic waste recycling services. Beginning September 15, 2020, businesses that generate 2 cubic yards or more of solid waste per week must have organic waste recycling services.

- Fruits and Vegetables
- Meat/Poultry/Seafood (bones and shells)
- Bakery Items and Ingredients
- Coffee Grounds, Filters, Tea Bags
- Milk, Juices
- Ice Cream, Yogurt, Cottage Cheese
- Eggs
- Plants and Cut Flowers
- Grass Clippings
- Leaves, Weeds



UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Plastic Food Packaging/Wrap
- Latex and Plastic Gloves
- Coated and Plastic Take-out Containers (generally includes all cups)
- Paper Products (napkins, paper towels)
- Waxed Products: Corrugated and Paper
- Plastic Bags
- Glass Bottles and Jars
- Aerosol Cans
- Metal, Foil
- Polystyrene
- Twist Ties, Rubber Bands, Wire
- Tape, Rope, Twine
- Grease and Oil
- Liquids
