STAFF REPORT

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Committee receive and file the FY 2020-21 1st Quarter Financial Report.

DISCUSSION:

In accordance with the reporting requirements of Measure AA, staff is pleased to present the FY 2020-21 1st Quarter Financial Report (July 1, 2020 through September 30, 2020).

The annual revenues from the sales and use tax for FY 2020-21 is budgeted at \$2,100,000. The City has received \$600,218 in sales and use tax revenues through August 31, 2020 (29%).

The actual expenditures for the 1st Quarter 2020-21 are \$156,382, or 6% of the FY 2020-21 budget that totals \$2,716,900. The breakdown of the expenditures per department are included in the attached financial report. A summary of the activities by department are as follows:

Homeless Services

SWAG (Social Work Action Group): Staff made 145 Contacts with homeless clients during the 3-month period. 66 of those contacted accepted housing referral/assistance, 126 accepted Medical/Mental Health services and 3 accepted Adult Protective Services.

Discount Hauling & Cleanup Services-Removed 85 cubic yards of debris and cleaned up 6 separate locations of Encampments during the 3-month period.

Public Works-Road Maintenance

The public works crews completed a wide variety of maintenance and clean up within the public right of way. The following key items for the 1st Quarter (July-September 2020) include: repaired 3,649 sq ft of potholes, illegal signs removed: 152, hours spent removing illegal dump: 46 hours, trimmed trees: 135, and signs installed: 43.

Responses: 705, including a lifesaving event at the Farm of a teenager drowning, but kept alive by the new medic squad efforts.

Vehicle Status:

Medic Squad vehicle MS61 was delivered and put into service in October 2020.

The firm of Teaman, Ramirez and Smith, CPAs, are completing the independent audit of Measure AA for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2020. The audit report for FY 2019-20 will be presented and discussed with the Measure AA Oversight Advisory Committee at the February 2021 meeting.
